# THE EGBR 2026 SPRING SEASON

Go to the website at [www.eghardball.com](http://www.eghardball.com) to sign up for participation and submit payment for the 2026 Spring Season. Regular 2026 Spring Season fees are \$260 including 22 games, jersey, a team cap, socks, fundraising tickets, pizza card, cost of umpires and park fees. Supplemental players join the league late, usually after their high school season is over, and get 11 games for \$210. No early-bird discounts this year, but please sign up before February 1, 2026.

To complete registration through our secure site, please have your Visa or MasterCard information available. Also, please have a PDF copy or photograph of a recent utility bill showing your address and zip code that we will need you to upload for our use in dealing with the CSD on fields.

For Spring 2026, we are accepting applicants for league ages 12 to 16. Birth date range is 5/1/09 to 4/30/13 (League age 12-year-olds, who are birth date range 5/1/13 to 4/30/14, must obtain permission from their local Cal Ripken League to play up in Elk Grove Babe Ruth). Players new to the league or Team Sideline will need to provide a PDF COPY of their birth certificate. League 16-year-olds with birth dates from 5/1/09 to 4/30/10 will have pitching limits.

The Spring Season will consist of 22 games (typically one weekday and one Saturday game each week, but some weeks will have three games). Tryouts will be the first two weekends in February, the draft in late February, practices will start in March, and games will start April 6, 2026. The season will end approximately June 6, followed by a week of playoffs, and championship game and raffle on June 13, 2026. Tryouts are a tool to distribute talent evenly, no players will be cut.
